The Liver Imaging Reporting and Data System (LI-RADS), a Committee of the American College of Radiology (ACR), is an imaging system for standardized interpretation, reporting, and data collection for imaging examinations in patients at risk for hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC).

The LI-RADS Committee created an International Working Group (WG) to promote the dissemination of LI-RADS. International WG has created a survey entitled « [Imaging of HCC: An International Survey](#) ». The objective of this survey is to identify worldwide practices in imaging-based surveillance, diagnosis, and staging of HCC, including an understanding of LIRADS utilization and potential barriers to its adoption.

We are aiming for a broad audience, ideally a large and international sample of both general radiologists and abdominal radiologists. The data from this survey will be collected and managed by the Committee researcher. The results will be published and will shape the future version of LI-RADS 2021.
