

Call for proposals of candidates for the chair of the ESR Education Committee

Deadline: November 14, 2020

Proposals of candidates for the office of the ESR Education Committee Chair are sought from the delegates of the ESR National Societies and Subspecialties and Allied Sciences Committee by the Chair of the ESR Board of Directors. Re-election will not be possible.

If you wish to propose a candidate, your proposal must be accompanied by:

- an **acceptance in writing by the proposed person** that he/she would be willing to serve and to allocate the time required as per below details in order to fulfill the duties as Chair of the ESR Education Committee
- a **short CV in English** of the proposed person incl. a head and shoulders picture (max. 1000 words; in tabular form; clearly indicating all ESR/ECR commitments – see attached template)

Only **ESR full radiologist members in good standing during the calendar year 2020** may be proposed.

Responsibilities of the ESR Education Committee Chair

- ESR Education Committee is a statutory committee of the ESR, which shall advise on all educational matters within the Society, establish a structure for undergraduate and postgraduate education in radiology, including continuing medical education, and assessment programmes in collaboration with the Quality, Safety and Standards and the Subspecialties and Allied Sciences Committees. The Education Committee shall supervise and support the activity of the Radiology Trainees Forum (RTF). (see ESR statutes).
- ESR Education Committee Chair is a Member of the ESR Executive Council
- **ESR Executive Council meets 4 times a year**
- The Education Committee is administered by the Board of the Education Committee, which is chaired by the Education Committee Chair
- Meetings of the Education Committee Board and its Subcommittees (Radiology Trainee Forum SC, Undergraduate Education SC, e-Learning SC) are mainly held online
- The whole Education Committee incl. its delegates (delegates nominated by ESR Institutional Member Societies) meets once a year online or during ECR
- ESR Education Committee Chair is a member of the Programme Planning Committee of the ECR
- Attendance of all relevant meetings (incl. Executive Council meetings, Annual Leadership Meeting, ECR, respective Education Committee (Board) and Subcommittee meetings, etc) necessary
- Estimated time commitment - **approx. 10h per week**

Recommended qualifications of an eligible candidate:

- Professionally active radiologist with high professional and academic reputation
- Proven leadership (and management) experience and skills (previous leadership positions)
- Sufficient knowledge of and experience with ESR affairs
- Preferably good geo-political fit with other ESR officers (no overrepresentation from same country)
- Professional and personal integrity (no conflicts of interest affecting responsibilities in the ESR)
- Good working knowledge of English (as all ESR communication is done in English)
- Experience in national and international congress organisation
- Involvement in respective national and/or subspecialty society/societies
- Proven track record of scientific activity

The deadline for submitting your proposal is **Saturday, November 14, 2020** (two months prior to the scheduled date of the electronic elections). Any submission beyond that deadline will not be considered.

The **ESR Executive Council has the final responsibility to nominate up to three candidates** for the office of the ESR Education Committee Chair one month prior to the scheduled date of the electronic elections.

The candidates nominated by the ESR Executive Council will be announced on the ESR website on December 14, 2020 at the latest. The election will take place via electronic voting between January 14 and 27, 2021.
