



LAURA OLEAGA

Laura Oleaga was born in Oñate (Guipúzcoa/Spain). She received her medical degree from the School of Medicine of the Autonomous University of Madrid. She completed her training in radiology at the Hospital Donostia in San Sebastian. She trained as a Research Fellow in Magnetic Resonance Imaging at the University of Pennsylvania in the Department of Radiology. She served as a staff member specialist in Magnetic Resonance Imaging in the Hospital of Basurto (Bilbao). She earned a PhD degree in medicine from the University of the Basque Country (Spain). Dr Laura Oleaga was appointed Chair of the Radiology Department of the Hospital Clínic in Barcelona in 2009. Since 2008 she has also worked as Neuroradiologist at the Hospital Clínic of Barcelona and has served as Professor of Radiology at the University of Barcelona.

Prof. Laura Oleaga has been involved in many research projects. Her main scientific interests lie in the fields of neuroradiology and head and neck imaging.

Her research focuses mainly on imaging clinical applications and she has striven to combine scientific research with clinical work throughout her career. She has authored and co-authored more than 50 peer-reviewed scientific papers and seven book chapters. She is also an active teacher at many prestigious universities, scientific meetings and courses.

She has dedicated herself to teaching during her career, participating actively in the training programmes for residents and in multiple courses dedicated to education.

Prof. Laura Oleaga is an active member of many scientific societies and organizations. She served as vice-president of the Spanish Radiological Society (SERAM) from 2002 to 2006, and as Chair of the Scientific Committee of SERAM from 2006 to 2008. She was appointed as chair of the Education Committee of the European Society of Radiology (ESR) from 2015 to 2018.
